## Immersive podcast learning for students

WHAT?	Explicit training of students in podcasting skills
WHY?	Enabling high quality independent productions (a big step up from recording podcasts on phones)
WHO?	Groups of 12 — 16 students (e.g. New Student Leaders' group, Film & Drama classes)
WHERE?	At Podbooth Studio or at school (or a mix of these)
HOW LONG?	4 hour induction and immersion experience with emphasis on making sample podcasts
WHEN?	Before school year begins, and term time
